

4th Annual City of Yelm Patriot Day's Skateboard Competition

- What:** 4th Annual City of Yelm Patriot Day's Skateboard Competition
- When:** September 8, 2007 @ Yelm City Park
Competitors meeting at 1:15 p.m.
Competition begins at 1:30 p.m.
- Who:** Two divisions based on age:
Division One: Ages 12 and under
Division Two: Ages 13 and older
- Where:** City of Yelm's Skate Park
- Awards:** Trophies will be awarded to the top three finishers from each division.
- Rules:** Round One: Each skater will have 90 seconds to perform for the judges. The top six from each division will advance to round 2. In round two each skater will have 60 seconds to perform. The final three skaters will advance to the final round and have 60 seconds to compete. Skaters can bring obstacles that they wish to use in their routines. These obstacles must be able to be set up and removed in a timely manner. **All skaters must wear a helmet. You provide your own or we will provide one for you. No exceptions.**
- General:** The skate park will be roped off and closed to all non-competitors at 1:00 p.m. on the day of competition. Participants can register to skate up until 1:15 p.m. on September 8th. All participants must complete a registration form that is available inside the Yelm Police Station or can fill one out the day of the competition.
